



Privacy policy for the UK Bright Path Ishaya Teachers. (GDPR Compliance).

SCOPE

This policy covers information gathered and used by teachers of The UK Bright Path Ishayas' trading as individuals, but sharing access to a central database. Here you'll see why we collect information and how we'll use (process) it. If anything isn't clear or you have questions, just drop us a line at uk@thebrightpath.com

As Ishayas', your safety and wellbeing is everything to us, that's why we ask you to fill in a form before you attend any of our courses. We process this information under the lawful basis that it is in your legitimate interest.

The UK Bright Path Ishayas' respect your privacy and want to protect it, therefore we promise not to share any of your personal data with any third parties. What does that mean? We will never sell or give away your information to marketers or other people trying to sell you stuff.

WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

You do not have to give us any personal data in order to use most of our websites. However, if you are applying to take a course with us, we will collect your name, address and contact details as well as ask you to divulge any medical information that would be pertinent for us to know. We are not medical professionals and will only use this information to the best of our ability to serve your interests on the day of the course.

Depending on how you pay for your course, we may have financial information about you, but only in the form of a Bank Transfer receipt or PayPal receipt. The UK Bright Path Ishayas' do not directly collect, process or store financial information.

YOUR RIGHTS

You are entitled to see the information held about you. You may review, correct, update or change your personal data at any time. You may also request that we delete our records of your information. Otherwise it is our policy to keep your information stored in our secure cloud (electronic) for as long as necessary. We keep paper registers and sign up forms for a period of 7 years before we dispose of them safely and securely.

Automatically collected information

In addition, we may automatically collect information about the website that you came from or are going to. We also collect information on which pages of our websites you visit, IP addresses, the type of browser you use and the times you access our websites. However, this information is aggregated and is not used to identify you.

HOW WILL INFORMATION ABOUT YOU BE USED AND SHARED?

The information we collect allows us to:

- Locate and put you in touch with a Teacher in your area;
- Contact you prior to a class to make sure you have all the information you need and communicate with you about how to pay;
- Provide teaching services in The Ishayas' Ascension of the Bright Path techniques;
- Administer our websites and provide customer services;
- Meet legal, regulatory and compliance requirements;
- Gather management information for research purposes and to form statistical and trend analysis;
- Send you surveys and competitions;
- Improve our websites and the products and services we offer to you and to provide you with online personalised services and targeted advertising including through the use of cookies when you visit our websites; and
- Provide you with information about our products and services which may be of interest to you from time to time.

We may employ the services of a third party to help us in certain areas, such as website hosting, support and maintenance. In some cases, the third party may receive your information. However, at all times, we will control and be responsible for the use of your information.

We may also use aggregated information so we can administer and improve our websites, analyse trends and gather broad demographic information. We may pass this information to third parties.

From time to time, The UK Bright Path Ishayas' may wish to provide you with information about our products and services (including by online targeted advertising, post, phone, email and text) which may be of interest to you.
